For developing low-carbon buildings, efforts are required from both the technology and management sides. The former side aims to develop low-carbon solutions, such as energy-efficient HVAC systems and renewable energy technologies, to reduce the energy needed to run building systems. The latter side aims to develop effective management solutions for construction projects to promote the efficiency of people's decision-making. This special session aims to bring researchers and practitioners from both the technology/engineering side and the management side to share their experience in delivering energy-efficient buildings. It is believed that this interdisciplinary nature will promote future collaborations between various construction professionals.
